

## USC Fraternity/Sorority Membership Policy Change Task Force

Task Force Charge and Purpose  
October 23, 2017

The task force will examine the details related to implementation of the Fraternity/Sorority Membership Policy change. The task force is chaired by Associate Vice Provost, Dr. Monique Allard, and includes representation from:

- Fraternity/Sorority Councils (AGC, IFC, MGC, NPHC, & PHC)
- Undergraduate Student Government
- Fraternity and Sorority Leadership and Development
- Inter/national Organization Representatives
- Residential Education
- University Housing
- Campus Activities
- Student health
- Department for Public Safety

The task force will meet approximately 4 times in the academic year to discuss and recommend:

- Considerations for new student well-being, behavior accountability, and involvement opportunities
- Opportunities to enhance university education (hazing prevention, consent and healthy relationships, well-being, at-risk substance use, etc.) for new students
- Considerations to minimize potential financial and housing impacts to chapters and if opportunities are available
- Potential considerations for first semester transfer students
- Identified impactful practices conducted at peer institutions with similar eligibility requirements
- Strategy for confirming student status, units, and GPA

The task force will engage council-specific work groups to discuss and make recommendations regarding council specific topics such as:

- Opportunities to minimize potential financial impacts to individual chapters
- Terms (fall and/or spring) for recruitment/intake
- Guidelines for interaction with students interested in joining
- Officer terms and elections
- Options for chapter housing needs, if applicable
